



ACCESS CONSIDERATIONS

The following are the most common items affecting access, although any site may have unique features. If in doubt, please ask. Many issues can be overcome with proper planning. In most instances the delivery vehicle will need to pull directly alongside the event location.

Please take into consideration the roads approaching the site as well as the site itself.

DELIVERY AND COLLECTION ACCESS CONSIDERATIONS

1. Heavy goods vehicle or weight restriction (Our vehicles are no more than 7.5 ton but sub-hired vehicles may be up to 18 ton, please check with us if you are unsure)
2. Narrow lanes or gates
3. Loading zones and parking restrictions
4. Parking dispensations/parking permits
5. Sharp bends in access roads or on site
6. Low clearance under bridges or other structures
7. Overhanging trees and foliage
8. Overhead power lines or other cabling
9. Arched gates
10. Soft surfaces
11. Security clearances
12. Site safety restrictions
13. Some furniture is very heavy and if the delivery crew deem it unsafe to carry large heavy items an unreasonable distance or up stairs, we may not be able to deliver these items. This is the same for collection.

Delivery charges and penalties may still apply if delivery is attempted but called off due to an undisclosed access or loading/unloading restriction.
